#### 1. Apologies for Absence.

#### 2. To receive Declarations of interest and requests for dispensation to discuss, or discuss and vote on a matter in which a Member or co-opted Member has a Disclosable Pecuniary interest (DPI).

#### 3. Public Participation – A period of not more than twenty minutes will be made available for the public to ask questions or submit comments.

A resident, Mr Smith, read from a prepared statement (copy attached) regarding the proposed parking restrictions on Talbot Road and the results of the parking survey.

Cllr Hall replied that the results of the parking survey were not yet complete but would be ready in time for the public meeting on Thursday 14th January.

Cllr Browne replied that he accepts the traffic restrictions were included in his report at the last Parish Council meeting, however Traffic Regulation Orders (TRO's) are actually a CEC issue rather than a Parish Council issue, therefore, any queries should be addressed to him as ward member and not the Clerk. He also reported that CEC Highways specifically requested that he did not discuss the proposed TRO's until they had actually been published and gone out to public consultation. The TRO's will be published and go out to public consultation at the end of January, the consultation will last for three weeks and all interested parties will have the chance to make their representations to CEC.

A resident, Mrs Bullock stated that she would prefer to see a car park on Heyes Lane as opposed to Chorley Hall Lane. She is holding a dance in the Festival Hall in May and is worried about the lack of parking.
