Alderley Edge parish council recommends refusal of the application as it isn't in keeping with other local advertising boards in being internally lit rather than over lit and of considerable size. Additionally, it could cause light nuisance to overlooking residential properties.

Alderley Edge parish council strongly recommends refusal of the application and call in to committee. The application is situated within the conservation area and is not conformant to local plan policies (BE12/H9) in not maintaining sylvan low density housing. It seeks to increase the existing sites compliant density three fold. It will not preserve existing plot width and spacing between houses. The physical scale of each proposed plot is not sympathetic to the local character and collectively will be an overbearing massing. The proposal will also lead to loss of privacy to neighbouring properties. The submission does not suitably evidence clear lines of visibility for ingress / egress of vehicles and it is questionable that for 3# five bedroom houses that on the site there will be sufficient passing space or accommodation for deliveries etc. There is insufficient parking provision for the individual properties size and inadequate privacy and external amenity space for intended occupants. Overflow of vehicles onto Underwood Road could not be accommodated.
