14. Reports from Councillors.

Cllr Chapman reported that the judging for the AE In Bloom Group took place last Tuesday and the results are due in November. The judges were seemingly very impressed with all areas, especially Wood Gardens. She attended an NHS meeting in Holmes Chapel and now has a contact regarding transport for senior citizens in the village which she will be following up. She attended the Brookview Care Home open day, joined the Speed Watch team and has done a couple of volunteer shifts in the library.

Cllr Browne reported that the Local Plan Part 2 submission draft is going to a special meeting of the strategic planning board on 24th July and then to be approved for consultation at special cabinet meeting on 2nd August, published for consultation thereafter. West Street will be closed on Monday 15th July to allow works for the planned one-way system which is scheduled to be in place by 2nd August.

Cllr Dudley-Jones reported he has a meeting with the Traveler's Advisory Team at Cheshire West on Thursday. He will report back with his findings and start to put an SOP together.
