The Parish Council recommends refusal of this application. The size of the extension, by nature of its scale and mass, renders it unneighbourly and an overdevelopment of the plot. The inclusion of a window to the side, first floor level, will result in a loss of privacy and residential amenity. The style of the extension and size, means that the proposed dwelling will not be in keeping with the properties in the immediate area, being a development of two bedroomed semi-detached properties. This change contravenes Policy DC.3 of the MBC Local Plan. which is a saved policy.

The failure to provide on-site parking with the loss of the drive and garage, means vehicles can only be parked on the street, which is a narrow road with little or no room for on-street parking. There is insufficient room to the front of the property to allow parking on the front garden, without infringing the pavement/highway.
