Cllr Marshall is working on getting quotes for the new Christmas tree lights and will report back further.

Cllr Browne reported London Road between the junction of Heyes Lane and Clifton Street will be closed on 22nd May to relay ducting and upgrade the pelican crossing. Moss Road at the junction of Duke Street and Heyes Lane and the remainder of Moss Road will be having level 2 carriageway patching this year.

Cllr Dudley-Jones reported that he would like to discuss further the offer from Assura to purchase the Medical Centre and he has communicated this to them. He also reported he is working on finalising the allotment leases.
