Cllr Fogharty reported on the Northern Planning appeal for Red Acre. There were some conditions attached to it and the permitted development rights were removed, which means they can't extend further after it's built without going through the plans process again.

Cllr Dudley-Jones reported he is hoping to finish painting the Jubilee Gates next week.

Cllr Browne reported he has had feedback from residents concerning Beech Road Park. The Parish Council have invested in the main park but he thinks Beech Road needs some attention. He asked for the lengthsman to have a look at wiping down some equipment. He suggested the new Parish Council may want to consider working alongside Cheshire East and make a financial contribution to improve the park.
