10. To agree spend on Christmas Lights maintenance.

The spend of £5600 had previously been agreed subject to queries around the guarantees being resolved. The guarantee is 24 months for everything except the timers which has 12-month guarantee.

11. Reports from Councillors.

Councillor Garbett reported that he has been in contact with the organiser of this year's Poppy Appeal and intends to start work on the Remembrance Service in the near future.

Councillor Booth advised that the surveyor is still trying to contact the pharmacy.

Councillor Bell gave an update on the business meeting with Councillors Fogharty and Howes. They are planning to produce a newsletter for businesses to include what the Parish Council does and activities that they can get involved in e.g. shop window competitions, small business Saturday on 6th December. In addition, they are planning a personal visit to all business's and would like to create a webpage on the Parish Council website. She also reported that she is continuing her work on projects for youth engagement, with a visit to the local school soon.

Councillor Browne reported that CE highways will be carrying out surfacing works on Heyes Lane and the road will be closed for up to 7 days in the last week in July.

He has received correspondence from a representative at Story Homes who have advised that they will be writing to each councillor regarding a development plan for a site at Ryleys Farm.

Councillor Bates advised that the deadline for the articles for the next Village News is 20th June 2025.

She also reported that the RHS judges will be visiting the village on the 8th of July and all councillors are welcome to join them afterwards for tea and coffee at Nook and Cranny.

Alderley Edge In Bloom, Wilmslow Clean Team, and Alderley Park (Bruntwood) completed a litter pick on the bypass and collected fifty bags of rubbish.

The Mayor of Wilmslow has been in contact to advise that the towns Pride Event will take place on Saturday 27th September 2025. They are holding a planning meeting for this on 25th June and councillors are welcome to attend if they wish to.

Councillor Chapman reported there is a wellbeing event being held in the Scout Hut on Thursday 19th June.
